**Subject: Europa Grey Castors**

We are pleased to announce some more additions to our castor range. The Europa range of castors has been a successful product for Artia for a number of years and we have added a new colour variation to the range, a grey bodied castor.

The Europa Grey range consists of 75mm diameter castors with polyurethane (PU) treads.

The new products are the grey body / black tread version, as opposed to the existing black body / grey tread. The two versions are brake and non brake



**Europa Grey**

“Europa Grey” castors are nylon bodied twin wheel castors with riveted wheels. Riveting the wheels is different to the standard “clip-on” style wheels and for this reason they are a much stronger castor. The PU wheel is a softer material than the usual nylon giving it better performance on hard floors, although it is still suitable for soft floors also. The appearance and manufacturing standard are of a high quality. The finish of the tyres is gloss black or grey.

The body is robustly constructed and is well finish. The surface finish is a fine textured grey / silver paint, or textured black.

**Technical Information**

All items have been given thorough quality inspection to ensure the goods are of high quality including impact and drop testing, and are rated to 70kg (dynamic).

These castors have a polyurethane tread, which is a soft wheel, ideally suited to hard floors, but also performs well on softer surfaces.

Fitting is by square swivel plate. 42mm x 42mm x 2mm thick, with 32mm hole centres. The overall height is 85mm.

The brake is a stepped design and locks into both wheels. It is both strong and effective.
